Methodology

Purple Insights conducted 800 telephone interviews of Battleground State Voters between May 31 and June 5, 2016.

Respondents were randomly selected from a voter file.

- Sixty-four percent (64%) of the interviews were completed with voters on landline
- 36% were completed with voters on their cell phones

The margin of error is +/-3.5%.

Key Findings

- Battleground State voters are nearly unanimous in recognizing the importance of American medical discovery
- These voters understand the benefits that medical discoveries provide both for patients and the country
- Battleground State voters believe policies that support medical discovery should be a priority for lawmakers and candidates for Congress.
- There is strong support among Battleground State voters for policy proposals that enhance medical discovery in America
- Battleground State voters overwhelmingly support developing public-private partnerships to encourage medical discovery, and understand that advancements come from the combined efforts of the private sector, academic institutions and government agencies






Battleground State voters are nearly unanimous in recognizing the importance of American medical discovery










Battleground State voters think policies that support new medical discoveries should be a priority for lawmakers and candidates for Congress


Regardless of who wins the presidential election in November, do you think that policies that will foster the development of new treatments and cures should or should not be a priority for the next president in their first 100 days in office?







Do you think that policies that will foster the development of new treatments and cures for diseases should or should not be a top priority for your Member of Congress and candidates for Congress?










There is strong support among Battleground State voters for policy proposals that enhance medical discovery







Battleground State voters strongly support developing public-private partnerships and collaboration is expected




Sustain public and private sector funding that helps lead to new treatments and cures
